**SDG 1:** End poverty in all its forms everywhere



**SDG 2:** End hunger, achieve food security and improved nutrition and promote sustainable agriculture



**SDG 3:** Ensure healthy lives and promote well-being for all at all ages



**SDG 4:** Ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all



**SDG 5:** Achieve gender equality and empower all women and girls



**SDG 8:** Promote sustained, inclusive and sustainable economic growth, full and productive employment and decent work for all



**SDG 11:** Make cities and human settlements inclusive, safe, resilient and sustainable



**SDG 16:** Promote peaceful and inclusive societies for sustainable development, provide access to justice for all and build effective, accountable and inclusive institutions at all levels

World hunger, zoonoses and food-borne diseases impact millions of people worldwide

18% of the world's population is engaged in animal husbandry, processing or marketing of animal-based foods, and thus their livelihoods and socio-economic status depend on the health and welfare of animals

- c. Leverage the OIE network to maximise the delivery of support to Members

### Collaboration with partners

Optimising cooperation with partners to better respond to global challenges

- a. Develop the voice of the OIE in global policy dialogue
- b. Target collaboration for impact
- c. Further promote the added value of the OIE as a partner

### Efficiency and agility

An efficient and agile Organisation underpinned by modern internal processes and tools

- a. Optimise performance and results-based management
- b. Review the business model of the Regional Representations
- c. Develop an informal consultative mechanism to support the OIE strategy implementation
- d. Promote the OIE's social and environmental responsibility
