

# BSE standards: Implementation of BSE Standards related to the procedures of official recognition, annual reconfirmation, and maintenance of BSE risk status




# BSE standards: Implementation of BSE Standards related to surveillance, risk management, and trade recommendations



# Reference for Estimation of the date from which the risk of BSE agents being recycled within the cattle population has been negligible (starting date)

✓ For countries and zones with negligible BSE risk status: at least eight years prior to the year of official recognition by the OIE



✓ For countries and zones with a controlled BSE risk status: at least from the year of official recognition by the OIE







#### Global foot and mouth disease control strategy

#### Strengthening global and regional coordination of FMD control

- Global coordination committee for FMD control (GCC-FMD)
  - 2nd meeting to developing activities for enhanced global coordination for 2027
- Assessing and monitoring global and regional progress in FMD control
  - 26th Meeting of the OIE Sub-Commission for FMD in South-East Asia, China, and Mongolia
  - Roadmap meetings: Western Africa, Eastern Africa and Midde East
  - Epidemiology and Laboratory network meeting for West Eurasia
  - Evaluation of implementation of the national, regional and global FMD strategies
- Addressing the threat of FMD serotypes O and A in the SADC region (April 2022)



- New opportunities (road building)



#### Peste des Petits Ruminants Global Control & Eradication Strategy

- The revision of the PMAT has been finalised, soon online
- FAO/OIE Guidelines for the Control and Prevention of PPR in Wildlife Populations is available online
- OIE PPR Vaccine bank renewed for 2022-2025, thermotolerant vaccine included
- Infographics on PPR diagnosis and on vaccination against PPR released in French and English
- Workshop of OIE PPR reference laboratory held and website published
- Second phase of implementation of the PPR Global Eradication Programme under preparation, based on extensive consultations with all involved regions, PPR GREN, main donors and stakeholders







## Rabies—Zero by 30

## Expert missions and annual reconfirmations

- for recognition and maintenance of official status / endorsed programmes
- Virtual interviews as an alternative option to field missions
  - Second virtual interviews performed in December 2021 for the maintenance of an official status
  - Option of virtual interviews added to the OIE Standard Operating Procedures on official recognition of animal health status and endorsement of official control programmes (Mission\_SOP)
- A total of 381 annual reconfirmations were assessed
  - Of these, 56 were comprehensively evaluated by SCAD
- The list of Members proposed for retention on the list was communicated to the Members on 17 March 2022.
- Online platform on official status/endorsed programme recognition is under development by the OIE



#### Terrestrial Animal Health Code Commission

#### One meeting of SCAD and TAHSC bureaus

- The bureaus discussed topics of common interest in February 2022:
  - Terrestrial Code chapters
    - 11.4 and 1.8 (BSE)
    - 8.16 (rinderpest)
    - 8.8 (foot and mouth disease)
  - Update on (de)listing assessments
  - Case definitions
  - Emerging diseases SOP
- Joint SCAD-TAHSC Taskforce approach



# Biological Standards Commission

- The Biological Standards Commission meets before this Commission (SCAD), which allows for sequential consideration of topics including case definitions and (de)listing assessments.
- Both Commissions were consulted on concerns raised by Members about the DIVA PCR methods used to distinguish vaccine strains from field strains of **lumpy skin disease virus**, and the challenges encountered in recent years with correctly identifying new recombinant field strains that have emerged in certain parts of the world.





Disease control: specific issues

# Development of case definitions

#### Endorsed by SCAD

- Infection with bovine pestiviruses (bovine viral diarrhoea)
- Infection with Nipah virus (Nipah virus encephalitis)
- Infection with Coxiella burnetii (Q fever)
- Infection with camelpox virus (camelpox)



# Listing assessments

#### In progress

- Additional information to be sourced:
  - Infestation of honey bees with Acarapis woodi
  - Infestation of honey bees with Tropilaelaps spp.
- Ready for assessment by SCAD:
  - strangles (infection with Streptococcus equi; not currently listed)

#### **Finalised**

- Decision: maintain listed status
  - West Nile fever
  - paratuberculosis







# SCAD future work programme

- Chapter 1.2 'Criteria for the inclusion of diseases, infections and infestations in the OIE list'
  - Are the current criteria relevant, appropriate, and fit for purpose?
- Chapter 1.3 'Diseases, infections and infestations listed by the OIE'
  - Review of the categorisation used, including consideration of implications for notification
- International trade of live insects: Impact on animal health
  - Discussion potential role of the OIE
