What is their desired duration for the learner completion of the course? If we could count it using PowerPoint slides, what would be the <u>number of slides</u> each course could have?</p>	<p>The estimated total duration of the eLearning modules is described in paragraph 4.1. – Format, structure, and localisation specifications. Page 10.</p>
Document B	<p>Will WOAHA assign a subject matter expert to the project team or is it WOAHA's expectation that your selected supplier has subject matter expertise to allow them to develop the content (based on existing WOAHA training material or similar) which then will be transformed into e-Learning modules?</p>	<p>The role of WOAHA project team is described in paragraph 3.2 – Governance (page 5) and in paragraph 4.1 – Development steps and timeframe (page 11).</p> <p>The expected requirements of the project team are described in paragraph 5.1.4 – Allocated human resources. Subject matter experts are included. They are expected to contribute with high level specialist expertise to the module development</p> <p>Also review the paragraph 4.7 – Evaluation of Tenders of Document A (page 11), assigning a weight of 30% to the quality of the project team. Guidelines for the development of OIE online modules	In the document THE E-LEARNING REQUIREMENTS (no 5) it is stated that 'At least one <u>subject matter expert per topic</u> serve(s) as course author(s) to develop the e-Learning module content and to support the e-Learning module's accuracy, currency, and credibility'. Can you please provide more information about the subject matter expert eligibility specifications and also the specific topics of these courses? Is the candidates responsibility to find matter experts?	The expected requirements of the project team are described in paragraph 5.1.4 – Allocated human resources, of Document B. Subject matter experts must be included. They are expected to contribute with high level specialist expertise to the module development. The topic of the courses have to be designed by the interested tenderer
