Foot and mouth disease is a highly contagious, viral disease

What is foot and mouth disease (FMD)?

which can spread rapidly from one animal to another.

Although it is rarely fatal in adult animals, it causes serious production losses and is a major constraint on international trade. FMD is not readily transmissible to humans and is not a public health risk.

Who is affected by FMD?

All domestic cloven-hoofed animals are susceptible, including cattle, swine, sheep and goats.






