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Self-declaration of the recovery of a zone (Great Britain) free from infection with high pathogenicity avian influenza viruses (HPAI) in poultry by the United Kingdom

Declaration sent to the World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH, founded as OIE) on 02 April 2024 by Professor Christine Middlemiss, WOAH Delegate for the United Kingdom and UK Chief Veterinary Officer, Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs.

1. Introduction

The objective of this self-declaration is to demonstrate zonal disease freedom status from high pathogenicity avian influenza (HPAI) viruses in poultry in accordance with the provisions of Article 10.4.6. of the WOAH *Terrestrial Animal Health Code (Terrestrial Code)*. The self-declaration covers Great Britain (GB), a zone of the United Kingdom (UK) that consists of England, Scotland, and Wales. It describes 364 outbreaks of HPAI subtype H5N1 in poultry and other captive birds that occurred in GB between October 2021 and February 2024.

Zonal freedom was declared for Northern Ireland on 31 March 2023 and remains effective.

The United Kingdom formally requests that WOAH publishes this self-declaration for the recovery of zonal freedom, of Great Britain, from HPAI viruses in poultry. The starting date of the self-declaration is 29 March 2024. The statement of the delegate responsible for this self-declaration can be found in Annex 1.

2. Avian influenza situation in Great Britain

The UK previously self-declared disease freedom from notifiable HPAI viruses on 3 September 2021, in accordance with the requirements of the *Terrestrial Code*, following outbreaks of HPAI subtypes H5N1 and H5N8. GB remained free of HPAI until 26 October 2021, when the first outbreak of HPAI subtype H5N1 was confirmed at a rescue centre in Worcestershire, England, through laboratory testing. All outbreaks were confirmed by real-time polymerase chain reaction (RT-PCR) and virus isolation testing at the WOAH and UK National Reference Laboratory (NRL), Animal and Plant Health Agency (APHA), Weybridge. Furthermore, all outbreaks of HPAI subtype H5N1 were confirmed as the Eurasian strain through genetic sequencing. Outbreaks were promptly reported to WOAH via the World Animal Health Information System (WAHIS). A summary of the outbreaks in GB covered by this self-declaration can be viewed in Tables 5-7 in Annex 2.

Occurrence of HPAI subtype H5N1 outbreaks in GB

A total of 364 outbreaks of HPAI subtype H5N1 were confirmed in poultry and other captive birds in GB between 26 October 2021 and 14 February 2024. There were 152 outbreaks between 26 October 2021 and 30 September 2022,

206 between 1 October 2022 and 30 September 2023, and 6 between 22 October 2023 and 14 February 2024. Table 1 presents the distribution of outbreaks per month per outbreak season. The outbreaks occurred in a range of holdings, including commercial poultry premises, backyard poultry flocks, captive birds, rescue and rehabilitation centres, and zoological collections. However, these were not uniformly distributed between the three nations comprising GB; 298 occurred in England, 51 occurred in Scotland, and 15 occurred in Wales. Table 2 delineates the number of HPAI subtype H5N1 outbreaks in England, Scotland, and Wales per outbreak season.

Occurrence of HPAI subtype H5N1 outbreaks in poultry

Two hundred sixty-five outbreaks of HPAI subtype H5N1 were confirmed in poultry, with the first on 07 November 2021 and the last on 14 February 2024. There were 104 outbreaks in poultry between 1 October 2021 and 30 September 2022, 155 between 1 October 2022 and 30 September 2023, and 6 between 1 October 2023 and 14 February 2024. A map illustrating the locations of HPAI outbreaks confirmed in poultry between 26 October 2021 and 14 February 2024 is provided in Annex 3.

Occurrence of HPAI subtype H5N1 outbreaks in other captive birds (non-poultry)

HPAI subtype H5N1 was also confirmed in 99 other captive bird (non-poultry) premises, with the first on 26 October 2021 and the last on 15 September 2023. There were 48 outbreaks in other captive birds between 1 October 2021 and 30 September 2022 and 51 between 1 October 2022 and 30 September 2023. Table 3 demonstrates the number of HPAI subtype H5N1 outbreaks in poultry and other captive birds per outbreak season.

3. Control and eradication measures in response to avian influenza outbreak

Avian Influenza is a notifiable disease in the UK in accordance with national legislation in [England](#), [Scotland](#), [Wales](#) and [Northern Ireland](#). Vaccination for the prevention and control of avian influenza (AI) is not permitted for poultry and other captive birds in GB. However, vaccination is permitted for zoo birds in England in compliance with [The Avian Influenza and Influenza of Avian Origin in Mammals \(England\) \(No.2\) Order 2006 \(as amended\)](#) and [The Avian Influenza \(Vaccination\) \(England\) Regulations 2006 \(as amended\)](#), subject to meeting eligibility criteria and attaining authorisation from APHA. Vaccination of zoo birds against AI is not currently permitted in Scotland and Wales.

GB implemented rapid and effective stamping-out programmes to eradicate the disease and control the outbreaks by following measures specified in national legislation, and the [Notifiable Avian Disease Control Strategy for Great Britain](#). All control measures and inspections were carried out promptly by APHA, which is the government veterinary service in GB. The Notifiable Avian Disease Control Strategy for Great Britain is consistent with the relevant provisions of the *Terrestrial Code*.

A rapid and effective stamping-out policy was implemented at all infected premises in accordance with the *Terrestrial Code*. Measures at infected premises included the humane culling of all birds on the infected premises and disposing of all bird carcasses in a bio-secure manner via rendering. Cleansing and disinfection (C&D) of the infected premises, equipment, vehicles, and anything that could spread the virus within and outside of the infected premises was also undertaken to destroy AI virus. The last HPAI outbreak was confirmed in poultry on 14 February 2024, culling of all birds and disposal of carcasses was completed on 18 February 2024. C&D in accordance with national legislation and Article 10.4.6 of the *Terrestrial Code*, was completed on the premises on 1 March 2024.

Following confirmation of an HPAI outbreak in poultry, a protection zone (PZ) of 3 km and a surveillance zone (SZ) of 10 km disease control zones were declared around infected premises (IPs). Disease control measures in the zones included movement restrictions of poultry, poultry products including hatching eggs, other captive birds, and other items likely to transmit disease to, from and within the zone. Personnel and vehicles entering or leaving restricted poultry and other captive bird premises in the disease control zones were required to observe rigorous biosecurity measures aimed at preventing the spread of the AI virus in accordance with national legislation and the Notifiable Avian Disease Control Strategy for Great Britain.

Where outbreaks of HPAI subtype H5N1 were confirmed in non-poultry (other captive birds), a protection zone (PZ) of 3 km and a surveillance zone (SZ) of 10 km disease control zones were declared around IPs. However, the relevant competent authority, in accordance with national legislation and following risk assessments, derogated from establishing a 3 km PZ and 10 km SZ disease control zones around 2 IPs. One contained 6 wild white-tailed eagles and the other contained 18 rescued seabird chicks. Following the same procedure, smaller disease control zones (3 km PZ or 3 km SZ) were declared around some non-poultry IPs. All 99 IPs were categorised as non-poultry (other captive birds) based on epidemiological investigations.

A census of all poultry and other captive bird premises in the PZs was undertaken. APHA carried out additional awareness raising with all poultry and other captive bird keepers in the zones, including writing to them to outline the restrictions in place, provide biosecurity advice and ensure the prompt reporting of suspicion of disease. All premises containing poultry in the PZ around poultry IPs were visited by APHA veterinarians to carry out a clinical inspection, and sampling was undertaken where required. All commercial poultry premises within the 3 km PZ around non-poultry IPs were clinically inspected by APHA veterinarians. Whilst non-commercial poultry premises were subjected to veterinary inquiry by APHA veterinarians, initially through phone to ascertain if there are birds on the premises and inquire about their health.

Sampling: 60 oropharyngeal swabs from non-indicator species, i.e. species that do not typically show clinical signs of avian influenza, e.g. Anseriformes, were collected from randomly selected birds per epidemiological group. All samples were tested using RT-PCR at the WOAH and UK National Reference Laboratory, APHA, Weybridge. No evidence of HPAI virus was identified (see Table 8 of Annex 4).

All commercial poultry premises in the SZs were contacted to check the health status of the birds. Any premises that reported suspicion of AI were immediately visited by an official veterinarian, and where disease could not be ruled out on clinical grounds, samples were taken and tested. No evidence of HPAI virus was identified.

Detailed epidemiological investigations were carried out following the confirmation of each case to identify the potential source and spread of infection to any further premises linked with the IP, either through known contacts or as a result of proximity. The [epidemiological report reviewing the GB outbreaks between 01 October 2021 and 30 September 2022](#) is available on the GOV.UK website. Epidemiological reports in respect to the GB outbreaks between 01 October 2022 and 14 February 2024 are being progressed and will be published [here](#) upon completion.

Re-population (restocking) of premises with sentinel birds was undertaken in accordance with national legislation. Re-population is not permitted until at least 21 days after final cleansing and disinfection has been completed and approved by APHA or after 12 months from initial cleansing and disinfection. Where sentinel re-population has been undertaken, clinical inspection and sampling of poultry were undertaken before premises were restocked. Further clinical inspection and sampling were undertaken during the 21 days following the placement of birds. Samples obtained prior to placement included blood samples, which were taken randomly from birds (20 samples for indicator species, i.e. species that typically show clinical signs of AI such as chickens, turkey and pheasants, or 60 samples for non-indicator species, per epidemiological group). Following placement, oropharyngeal swabs were collected from up to ten dead birds per epidemiological group per week, and cloacal swabs, where required. For non-indicator species, 60 oropharyngeal swabs were collected from each epidemiological group at 21 days post-placement. Testing of blood samples was by HAIT serology and swabs by RT-PCR. All results were negative.

Additional disease prevention and control measures

A range of additional measures were employed during periods of heightened wild bird incursion risk to protect poultry and stop the spread of the virus. Enhanced biosecurity measures were mandated when an Avian Influenza Prevention Zone (AIPZ) was declared, which included a ban on gatherings of Galliformes and Anseriformes, and mandatory housing was intermittently introduced. AIPZs that mandated housing measures required all poultry and other captive birds to be housed or confined in a manner which prevented access to wild birds. AIPZs were deployed regionally and nationally, in proportionate response to the risk in these areas and changes in the epidemiological situation, as determined by a risk assessment.

In all three GB nations, AIPZs with mandatory housing measures were in-force between 29 November 2021 and 02 May 2022. This was immediately followed by national AIPZs without obligatory housing until 16 August 2022 in England, Scotland, and Wales. Throughout autumn 2022, four AIPZs were declared on either a regional or national basis in GB without requiring housing measures, including the national Scottish AIPZ declared on 17 October 2022 and revoked on 04 July 2023. To strengthen preventative actions and following a risk assessment, AIPZs were subsequently introduced again in England (on 07 November 2022) and Wales (on 02 December 2022) with mandatory housing measures. In Wales, in association with the AIPZ, keepers also had to complete and act upon a compulsory biosecurity self-assessment review of the premises where birds were kept.

The additional measures were withdrawn gradually, following a risk assessment that determined the risk level had reduced. In England and Wales, mandatory housing measures for both poultry and captive birds were revoked on 18 April 2023, where an AIPZ without a housing order component remained thereafter. Following a further reduction in risk levels, the AIPZs in England, Wales and Scotland were lifted on 04 July 2023. Gatherings of Galliformes were permitted in England from 23 August 2023, in Scotland from 05 February 2024, and in Wales from 16 February 2024, provided that certain criteria are met and requirements of the applicable general licence are followed. However, gatherings of Anseriformes remain prohibited in all three GB nations. 4. Surveillance programme and early detection system

Great Britain has comprehensive and effective surveillance programmes to rapidly detect early incursion of disease and to demonstrate freedom from HPAI in poultry. This includes both passive surveillance in poultry and wild birds and active surveillance in poultry in accordance with Chapter 1.4. and Articles 10.4.26. to 10.4.30. of the *Terrestrial Code* as follows:

4.1. Passive Surveillance in poultry

Obligation to report a clinical suspicion of avian influenza

Avian influenza is a notifiable disease in the UK, as specified in national legislation. The reporting of suspicion of AI by poultry keepers/owners and private veterinarians is a legal requirement in GB. All suspect cases in GB are investigated promptly by an APHA veterinarian. If the veterinarian cannot rule out disease, official samples are collected and sent to the WOAH Reference Laboratory and UK National Laboratory, APHA Weybridge, for testing. Samples include oropharyngeal and cloacal swabs plus blood from live birds, and up to two fresh carcases, from each epidemiological group on the premises. Testing includes influenza A virus screening, HP H5, N1 and NDV screening RT-PCR assays, HAIT serology for Anseriformes and virus isolation in embryonated fowls' eggs.

Early Warning System

In addition to the obligation of reporting any suspicion, a scheme that enables testing to exclude the involvement of a notifiable avian disease, including AI, has been operating in GB since May 2014. Private veterinarians can request official laboratory testing of Galliforme (chicken and turkey) flocks in cases where the involvement of AI is not formally suspected but cannot be excluded from the differential diagnosis in a flock health or production problem.

Awareness programme

APHA continues to [monitor](#) for the risk of AI incursions in poultry and regularly engages with poultry industry stakeholders to raise awareness of the disease situation globally, including the need to always practice strict biosecurity measures and report suspicion of notifiable avian disease. During the outbreak period, in particular, regular meetings were held with stakeholders to continue to raise awareness of the importance of biosecurity. Press notices, social media platforms, text alert services and newsletters are used regularly to raise awareness to the poultry industry and the general public on the disease situation, the need for all bird keepers or owners to practice strict biosecurity and protect the health of their birds. Detailed [biosecurity guidance](#) has also been produced for poultry keepers to implement in order to reduce the risk of direct and indirect introduction of avian influenza virus into poultry premises from wild birds and other sources of contamination.

4.2. Active Surveillance in poultry

Serological surveillance programme

Active serological surveillance of avian influenza viruses in domestic poultry is carried out annually in GB, as required by national legislation. The programme is risk-based, targeted and is consistent with the sampling guidelines laid down in [Commission Decision 2010/367/EU](#). The sampling strategy takes into consideration the following factors:

- Areas at potentially higher risk of AI incursion
- Areas with presence of high densities of higher-risk poultry holdings
- Areas that have an increased abundance of certain species of wild birds

Serum samples are taken from a number of birds on each premises and screened for the presence of antibodies to AI viruses of subtypes H5 and H7. A full epidemiological investigation, together with PCR testing, is used in the case of a non-negative serological result to confirm whether the relevant flock is infected by an avian influenza virus. All samples are tested at the WOAH and UK National Reference Laboratory at APHA Weybridge. The results of AI surveillance in poultry undertaken in 2021, 2022 and 2023 across GB are detailed in Table 9 (See Annex 5).

Enhanced Surveillance

Enhanced Surveillance of poultry and captive birds was undertaken, where HPAI was confirmed, for a period of 30 days, following effective initial cleansing and disinfection. Premises located within the 0-10km zone around the IP were subject to both clinical inspection and sampling of high-risk poultry, such as Anseriformes. 60 oropharyngeal swabs from 60 non-indicator species were collected from randomly selected birds per epidemiological group on premises in the zone. All samples were tested using RT-PCR and were negative. Any clinically unwell birds were dealt with as suspect cases and subject to full veterinary inquiry, including diagnostic testing. Table 10 in Annex 6 presents the Enhanced Surveillance conducted in the disease control zones between October 2021 and March 2024.

4.3. Wild bird monitoring

Passive surveillance of wild birds is consistent with the requirements of [Commission Decision 2010/367/EU](#). In Great Britain, APHA operates a year-round virological survey of wild birds as an early warning detection system. This surveillance is made up of patrols by wild bird reserve wardens and collections of found-dead wild birds reported to APHA by members of the public. The first detection of HPAI subtype H5N1 in wild birds in GB was in a group of five pheasants collected on 17/10/2021. Table 4 summarises the results of passive surveillance of wild birds found dead in GB in 2021, 2022, 2023, and 2024. 5. Measures implemented to maintain freedom

National legislation is enforced in addition to strategies for effective risk management, risk communication to stakeholders, and enhanced on-farm biosecurity to safeguard the GB poultry industry from the risk posed by notifiable avian disease.

The governments of GB, on the basis of a veterinary risk assessment, can implement mandatory enhanced biosecurity measures in accordance with national legislation to reduce the risk of transmission of avian influenza to poultry from wild birds by declaring an AIPZ. These measures were previously implemented during the heightened risk period in 2021/2022 and 2022/2023 (See section 3).

In addition to the legislative powers which can be used to mitigate the risk, GB has implemented a comprehensive biosecurity awareness programme for avian influenza which involved the publication of regular disease updates to a wide range of stakeholders which can be accessed on the dedicated avian influenza webpages. These webpages are country-specific with separate pages for [England](#), [Scotland](#) and [Wales](#). During high-risk periods in particular, the government holds regular meetings with stakeholders to heighten awareness of the importance of biosecurity, operates a text alert service to communicate quickly with registered flock keepers and issues regular disease updates, biosecurity advice and information to the poultry industry via email. Online social media platforms are used to communicate with poultry and other captive bird owners to raise awareness to the risk and mitigating measures that they can take to prevent avian influenza.

Imports of poultry and poultry products into GB are carried out in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 10.4 of the *Terrestrial Code*. Under [the Border Target Operating Model](#) (BTOM), live poultry, including hatching eggs, germinal products, fresh poultry meat, most poultry meat products and eggs for human consumption, fall under either high or medium risk and will continue to require health certification. Poultry meat products that are shelf stable at ambient temperature and sterilised are considered [low risk](#) and are deemed safe products in line with Article 10.4.2 of the WOAH *Terrestrial Code*. Additionally, under the BTOM, some processed egg products that are shelf stable at ambient temperature are categorised as low risk, and thereby eligible to be imported with a commercial document instead of a health certificate from specified countries. The risk classification considers a) the disease status of the importing country, b) risk mitigation treatment the product had undergone to inactive disease agent (e.g. HPAI); c) risks to humans and animals associated with the product and d) history of good compliance (including of the operator and exporter).

6. Conclusion

Considering that:

- avian influenza is a notifiable disease in the United Kingdom;
- prior to the occurrence of the new outbreak in October 2021, the United Kingdom had been free from HPAI viruses in poultry since declaring freedom on 3 September 2021;
- a continuous awareness programme about the disease is in place;
- a stamping out policy, including cleansing and disinfection was applied to infected premises following confirmation of outbreaks (the last cleansing and disinfection was completed and approved on 1 March 2024);
- 28 days have elapsed as prescribed in Article 10.4.6. of the *Terrestrial Code* since the end of the cleansing and disinfection of the last infected premises;
- surveillance has been carried out in accordance with Articles 10.4.26. to 10.4.30. of the *Terrestrial Code*.

The WOAH Delegate of the United Kingdom declares that the zone (Great Britain) complies with the requirements for “a country free from infection with high pathogenicity avian influenza viruses (HPAI) in poultry” as of 29 March 2024, in compliance with the provisions of Chapter 1.6. and Article 10.4.6. of the *Terrestrial Code* (2022) and consistent with the information provided to WAHIS.

Statement to be included in the self-declaration document

I, the undersigned, Professor Christine Middlemiss, Delegate of United Kingdom to the World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH, founded as OIE), takes responsibility for the self-declaration of freedom from High Pathogenicity Avian Influenza viruses in accordance with the provisions of Article 10.4.6. of the *Terrestrial Code*.




