He is currently member of the Spanish standardization (AENOR) and advising (CEIEA) committees and of the international working group on standardization (ISO) on livestock electronic identification. He was elected member of the Catalonian Academy of Veterinary Sciences in 2005 and awarded with the International Dairy Production Award of the American Dairy Science Association (ADSA) in 2006.

Thesis and published more than 300 scientific and extension papers and granted 4 international patents. He also conducted different cooperation and development projects and consultation with private and public companies and organizations (European Commission, FAO).
