

Dr Daniel Chaisemartin



Since March 2006, Dr Chaisemartin is Head of the Administrative and Management Systems Department at the World Organisation for Animal Health (OIE). He is in charge of the OIE information systems, the administration and logistics of the OIE, and in particular travels, meetings, conferences and General Sessions of the OIE. He is also responsible for giving support to other departments, in particular the management of the sanitary data and the work on identification and traceability of live animals.

From September 2002 to March 2006, he was Project Officer at the OIE Director General's Office.

From July 1999 to September 2002, he was Office Manager of the identification service and control service for live animals transfer at the French ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries, in charge of the identification of all animal species (administrative and technical aspects, European and national regulations, European projects), the control for live animals movements (administrative and technical aspects, European and national regulations) and the management of European exchanges (administrative and technical aspects, European and national regulations). He coordinated European projects ANIMO, ADNS, SHIFT (national and European interventions) and IDEA (Electronic identification) and realized missions in different countries (Member states and Third countries). From September 1996 to July 1999, he was Project Officer of the National Director of veterinary and phytosanitary services (CVO – OIE Delegate) at the French ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries. Dr Chaisemartin was also Manager of the team of veterinarian software at the French ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries.
