Dr. Kai-Uwe Sprenger is the Legislative veterinary officer in charge of animal identification and traceability for the European Commission, Directorate-General Health & Consumers and was deeply involved in the negotiation and adoption of recent EU legislation in the field of electronic identification of animals. He has also responsibilities in the field of zootechnics, animal biotechnology and genetic resources.
