

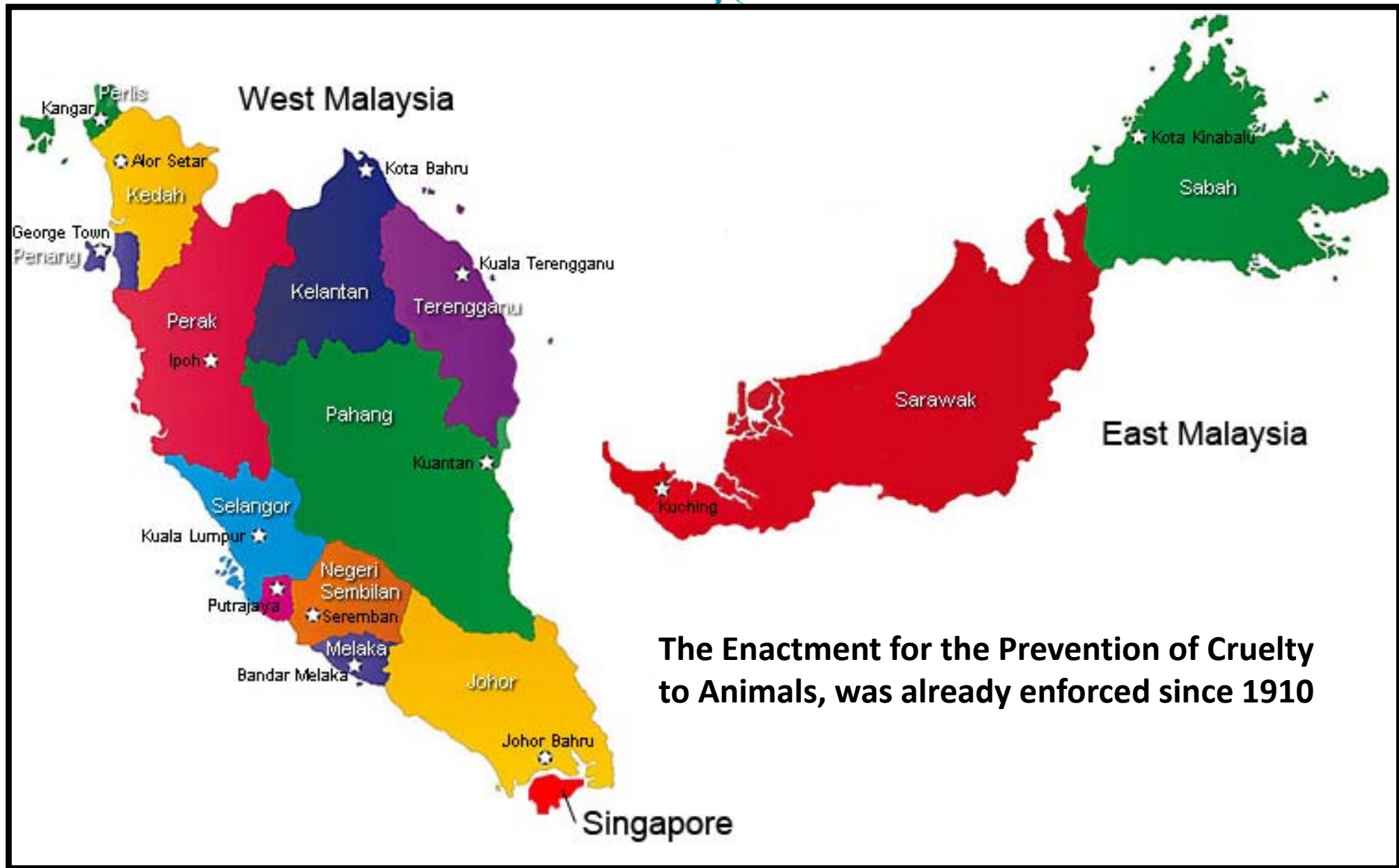

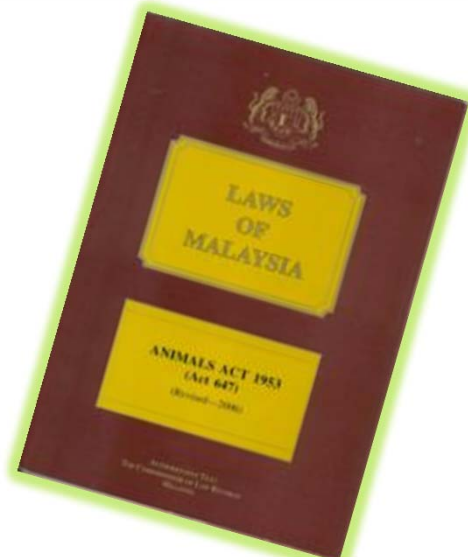
HISTORY



The Enactment for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals, was already enforced since 1910

ANIMALS ACT 1953

- The Animals Act 1953(Act 647), Revised-2006. Part V1: Prevention Of Cruelty To Animal (Amendment 2013).
- Penalty for cruelty has been raised to USD12,500 and jail term from 6 months to 1 year. This has been enforced since 1st August 2013.



GOOD ANIMAL HUSBANDRY PRACTICES MS 2027: 2006

Skills & Responsibilities of producers:
knowledge & skills on animal welfare

Cruelty; mistreatment, provide adequate
resources

Neglect: 5 freedoms-hunger & thirst,
discomfort, pain/injury/disease, exhibit normal
behavior, fear/distress

MALAYSIAN CODE OF PRACTICE FOR THE CARE AND USE OF ANIMALS FOR SCIENTIFIC PURPOSES

- The 'Malaysian Code Of Practice For The Care And Use Of Animals For Scientific Purposes' under the supervision of the *Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC)* is being used currently.
- The Code emphasises the duty of care that demands a genuine commitment to the welfare of the animals, a respect for the contribution the animals make to research and teaching and a desire to promote the animals' wellbeing.
- Encapsulated in the Code is the need in scientific and teaching activities to consider:
 - the Replacement of animals with other methods;
 - the Reduction in the number of animals used; and
 - the Refinement of techniques used to reduce the adverse impact on animals.

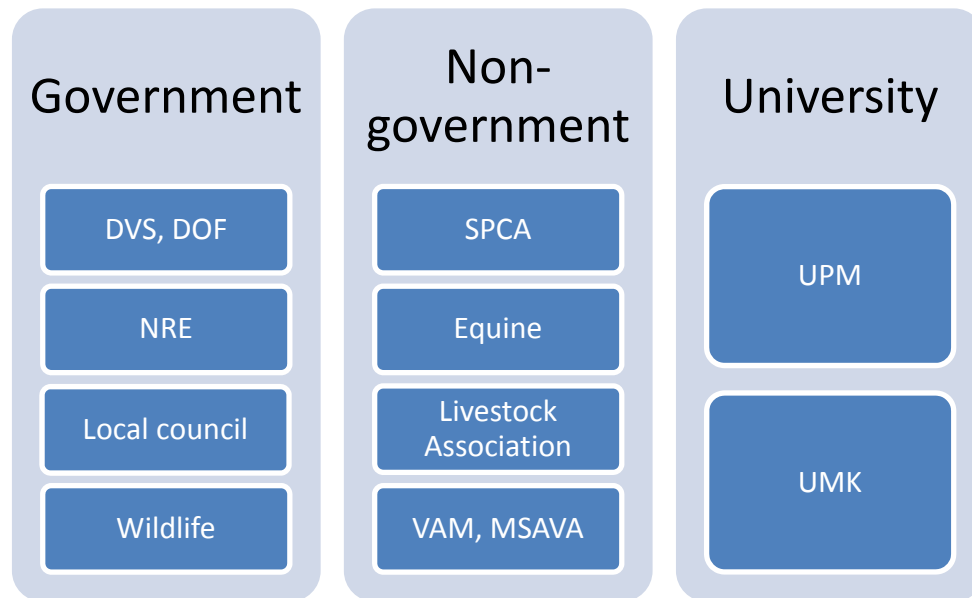

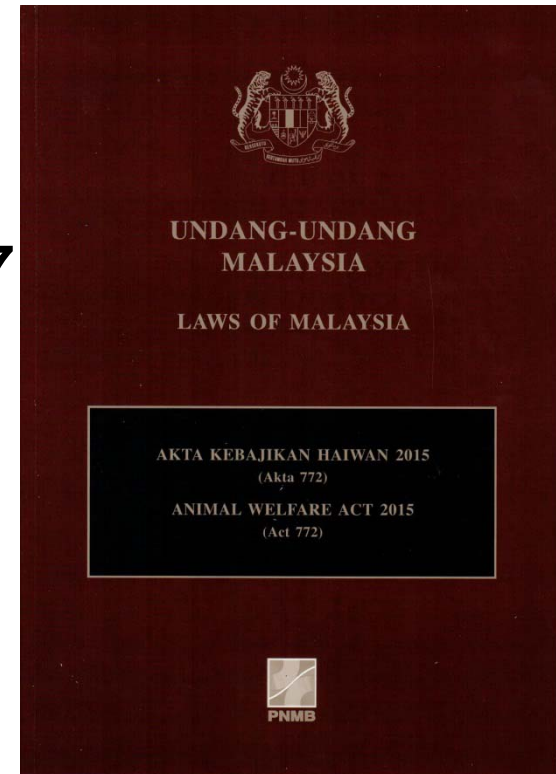

- Enforcement date: June 2017

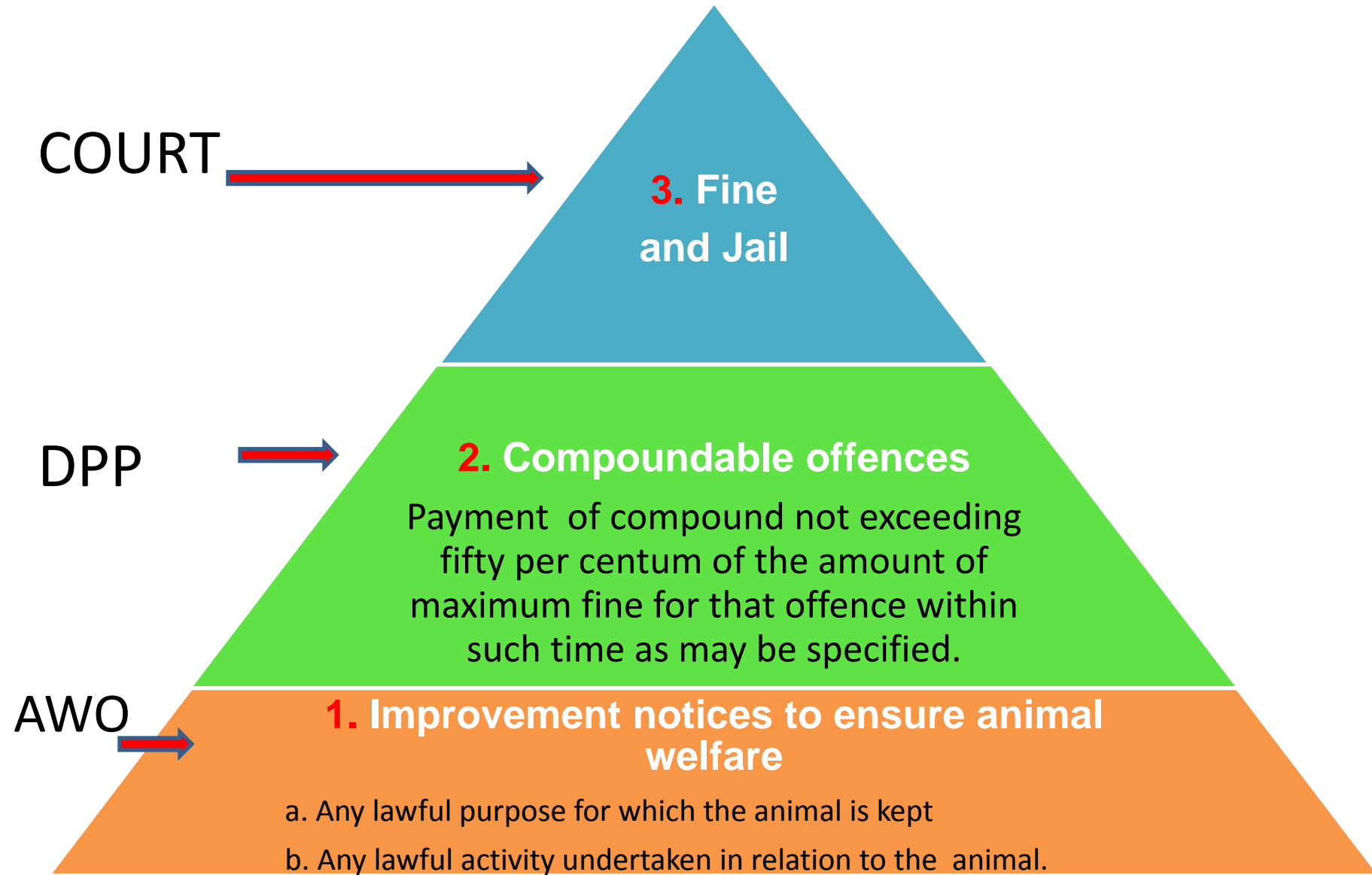

COURT MAY IMPOSE ADDITIONAL ORDERS WHEN SENTENCING

DEPRIVATION ORDER

after conviction of offence,
court may order confiscation
of animals & other items
involved in cruelty offences

DISQUALIFICATION ORDER

for such a period
owning, keeping or from participating in the
keeping of animals, (includes control or influence)
transporting or arranging for the transport of
animals.

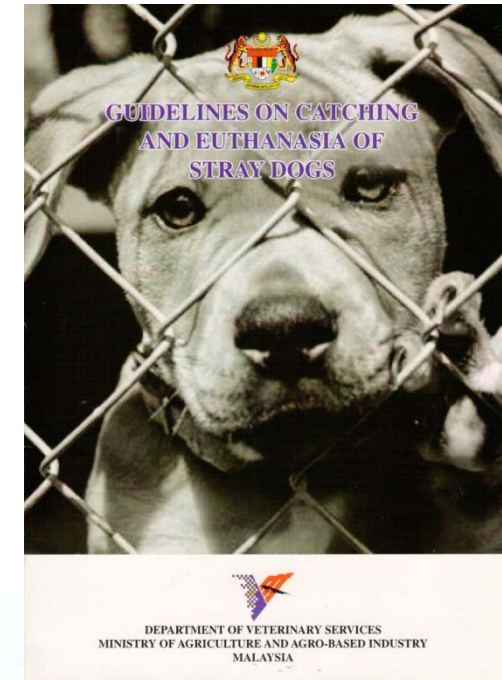

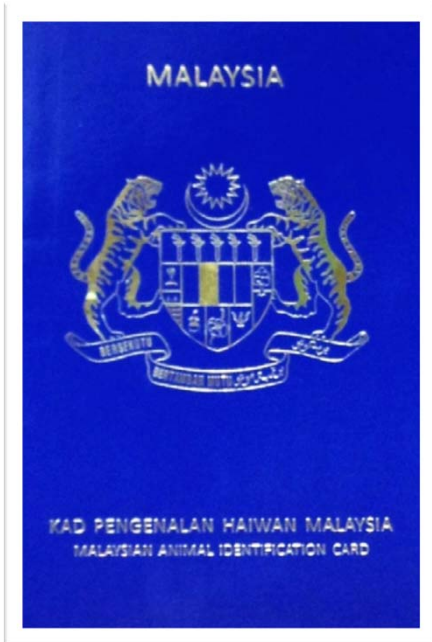

Usaha Norashikin mendapat perhatian pencinta haiwan yang sering menghulurkan bantuan bagi membiayai pembelian makanan dan barangan keperluan untuk haiwan pusat perlindungan kendalikannya. "Sebahagian besar mereka mptil menghulurkan ntu adalah kenalan Facebook. Setiap bulan ia perkhidmatan RM5,000 tuk sediakan keperluan an kucing dan anjing ng ada di sini, itu tidak masuk kos rawatan wan yang sakti. Dengan gaji saya, memang ik cukup, jadi terpaksa alkan muka meminta ma. Syukur wang derma ng ramai serta wang panan sendiri saya aya membina pusat lindungan ini seterusnya yelamatkan h banyak ng dan ng terbiar," nya.

Rancang bina lebih banyak hospital veterinar

Kuala Lumpur: Bagi mendepani kebendak serta memenuhi keperluan untuk menjaga kebajikan haiwan pada masa depan, Kementerian Pertanian dan Industri Asas Tani merancang untuk membina lebih banyak lagi hospital veterinar menerusi pelan Rancangan Malaysia ke-12 (RMK12).

Menterinya, Datuk Seri Ahmad Shahery Cheek berkata, pihaknya sudah mencadangkan perkara itu kepada Unit Perancangan Ekonomi (EPU).

Kementerian Kewangan dan berharap ia akan dimasukkan di dalam pelan pembangunan RMK12 kelak.

"Ini adalah perancangan Kementerian Pertanian dan Industri Asas Tani, kita melihat wujud keperluan untuk membina lebih banyak lagi hospital veterinar. "Kita hanya ada satu hospital veterinar milik Jabatan Perkhidmatan Veterinar (DVS) di Cheras dan semua masyarakat bertumpu di sini. Saya melihat perlu untuk kita membina lebih banyak hospital seperti ini di seluruh negara," katanya.

susulan pewartaan Akta Kebajikan Haiwan 2015 dan akta baru itu akan dikuatkuasakan pada tahun depan.

Mengulas berhubung jumlah hospital yang dicadangkan, Ahmad Shahery berkata, pihaknya hanya memohon untuk membina hospital dan jumlah itu bergantung kepada bajet kerajaan.

"Saya dengar memang ada kelesahan daripada pemilik haiwan peliharaan yang terpaksa menunggu lama, beratur panjang ataupun menunggu tarikh temuan yang agak lama.

"Ingin saya tegaskan bahawa DVS sedaya upaya memberi perkhidmatan yang terbaik, namun dalam keadaan dan kakitangan yang terbatas di samping permintaan yang tinggi.

"Senario hampir sama jika kita lihat sedekad lalu apabila semua orang bertumpu kepada Hospital Kuala Lumpur (HKL) untuk mendapatkan rawatan kerana pada waktu itu, hanya HKL saja yang menawarkan perkhidmatan," katanya.

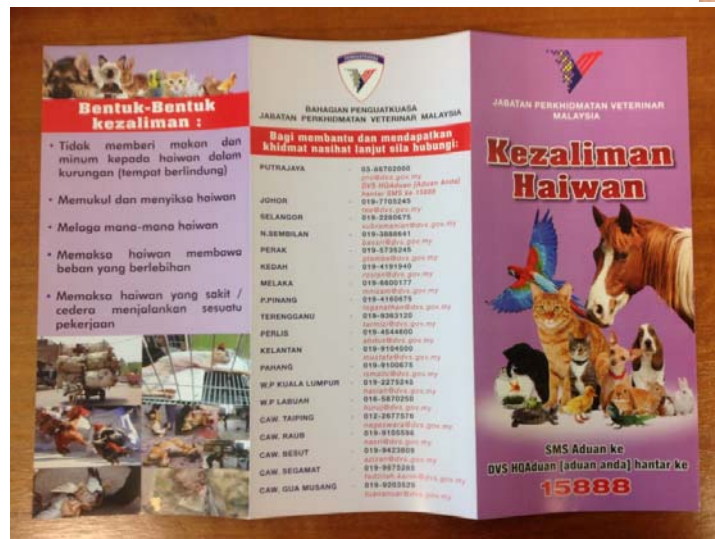

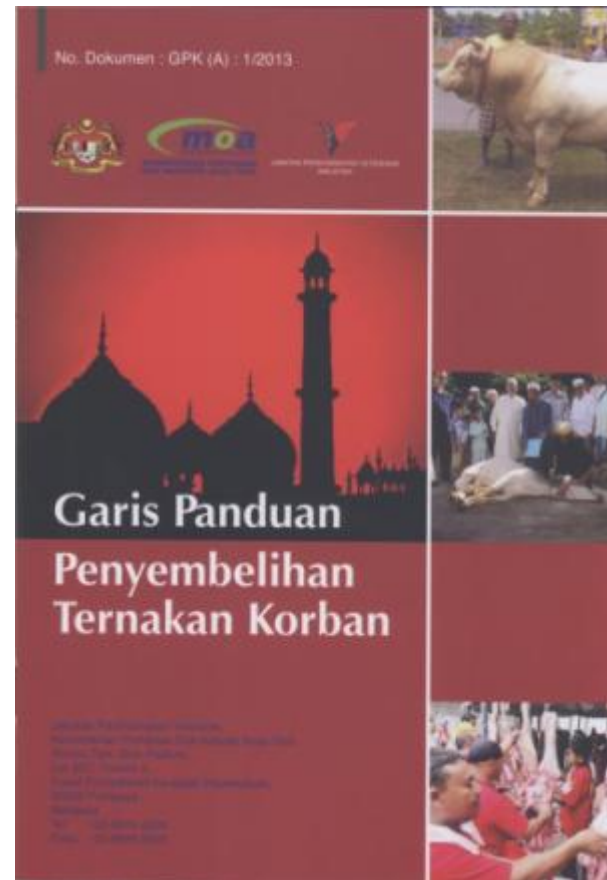
